

# GUIDELINES DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC – CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (CMCO) (EFFECTIVE FROM 11 MAY 2020 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE)

**KELAB GOLF BINTULU (KGB)** has established the following guidelines at this Club to primarily safeguard the health of golfers, employees and guests. The said guidelines are given by The Malaysian Golf Association (MGA) during the announcement on the reopening of Golf Clubs. It was intended to ensure that all Golf Clubs will undertake and enforce measures to strictly comply with the directives issued by the Ministry of Health.

The Guidelines as set up below serve merely as suggestion and guideline whereby MGA does not take any responsibility for any advices or matters stated herein below. In this regard, MGA disclaims all liabilities.

**KELAB GOLF BINTULU (KGB)** will do their utmost best to ensure that all directives by the Ministry of Health, laws, regulations, rules, and Standard Operating Procedures that are applicable from time to time are fully complied and adhered to. The players, either as a member or guest, you acknowledge that the game of golf and attendance at the Club, may be dangerous and you undertake such participation at your own risk and the Club and the Management Committee will not be liable.

#### **PRE-GAME**

- Golfers/employees with any colds or coughs or any symptoms of Covid-19 must refrain from playing golf/going to work;
- The Clubhouse and course are open for members only. However, reciprocal members from Affiliated Clubs in Sarawak are allowed to play provided accompanied by members one (1) member allowed to bring 1 (one) reciprocal members in a flight. Booking must be done by members only and they are responsible for the reciprocal members at the club. Payment of buggies for reciprocal members will be based on non-members rate.
- Booking must be made in advance through phone call to the Club (Tel. 252001or 253213);
- We are enforcing 1 golfer per buggy. However, twin-sharing of buggies are allowed provided they are family members with the same membership number, e.g. husband and wife, father and son, etc. Payment of buggies for twin-sharing case will follow the normal buggy approved rate.
- Players are NOT allowed to have Caddies;
- For members who have changed their contact number and **non-members**, details of golfers must be recorded i.e. current address and contact numbers so communication can be easily established;
- Online payment or bank transfer is recommended (e.g. Sarawak Pay, etc.);
- Golfers should register 20 minutes before tee time. Our Registration staff will be equipped with face masks. Hand sanitizers should be available at the Registration Counter/Starter's Shed;
- Temperature check for each golfer before entering the clubhouse and to wash and sanitize their hands;
- One golfer to register for each flight, but if already registered and paid, all players may proceed directly to Tee Box.
- Social distancing marker will be clearly outlined at the Registration Counter, F&B outlets, Pro Shop and others;
- Interaction should be limited between golfer and staff;
- Avoid congestion and congregation near the starting points.

## **DURING GAME**

- We insist on social distancing (minimum 2 metres rule) on Tee Grounds, Greens and throughout the rounds;
- We will remove or cover all touchable surfaces (bunker rakes, sand bags, ball washers, etc)
- Pin flags are not to be touched and left in the hole at all times. As per R&A Guidelines, no modification of definition of hole;
- Golfers can use his/her feet or clubs to smooth the area as recommended by the R&A;
- Tee time interval to be increased (recommended 10 minutes interval);
- Golfers should only pick their respective golf ball up;

- Divot must be repaired;
- Don't shake hands before and after the game.

## **AFTER THE GAME**

- Avoid crowding at shoe cleaning bay;
- Do not submit physical golf scorecards. Please take a picture and send the scorecards by WhatsApp to 012-8708945(Salleh) or email <a href="mailto:kelabgolfbintulu@gmail.com">kelabgolfbintulu@gmail.com</a>;
- Hand sanitizers should be available at the Registration Counter/Starter's Shed;
- Separate entry and exit to the Clubhouse to maintain social distancing.

## **OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES**

- Please maintain strict social distancing at every outlet including F&B as advised by the Ministry of Health;
- Golf Club will standby workers to sanitize after every usage at every outlet including Changing Room. We do not encourage the usage of Shower Room and Lockers;
- We will sanitise buggies before and after every use;
- Pro-shop will not provide rental sets, shoes, etc;
- We will be altering Driving Range Bays to comply with social distancing;
- We will sanitize touchable surfaces/carts/equipment/bathrooms daily or multiple times a day;

"We don't know how long this will last, and we can only hope the situation returns to normal as soon possible."
