



Local Rules

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf

1. **Out of Bounds - Rule 27-1**
Defined by white stakes, lines or fence posts.
To the left of the 1st, 5th, 15th, 17th, 18th Hole and behind 18th Green and to the right and left of Hole 6th.
2. **Water Hazards (Including Lateral Water Hazards) - Rule 26**
Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes or lines. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes or lines.
3. **Immovable Obstructions - Rule 24-2**
All artificial - surfaced roads including adjacent drain channels.
4. **Ground Under Repair - Rule 25-1**
Deep tyre ruts through the green, flower beds and areas defined by white lines or GUR sign.
5. **Protection of Young Trees**
Protection of young trees identified by blue stakes. Relief must be taken in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b - App.-1
6. **Relief from Edging Grooves**
If the ball lies on an edging groove around a putting green, the player may, without penalty, lift the ball, clean it and place it out of the groove in the nearest position to where it lay, whether on or off the putting green, which is not nearer the hole.
7. **Embedded Ball**
Relief extended to "through the green"
8. **Stones in Bunkers**
Stones in bunkers are movable obstruction (Rule 24-1 applies).

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES :

Match play - loss of hole; stroke play - Two strokes.
